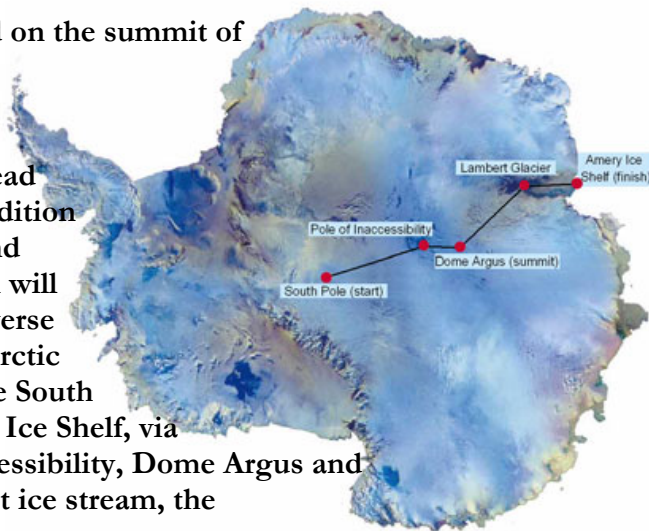

## ANTARCTIC EXPEDITION

Dome Argus remains as one of the greatest unexplored geographical features on Earth. Situated in east Antarctica it is the largest of all Antarctic ice domes, the highest point on the Antarctic plateau (4100m) and the highest point in Australian territory. It is also recognized as the coldest place on earth.

Nobody has stood on the summit of Dome Argus.

Next summer Eric Philips will lead a pioneering expedition to Dome Argus and beyond. The team will make the first traverse of Australian Antarctic Territory, from the South Pole to the Amery Ice Shelf, via The Pole of Inaccessibility, Dome Argus and the world's longest ice stream, the Lambert Glacier.
